

North Lake Little League All Star Commitment 2019

North Lake Little League is proud to compete in the District 8 All Star Tournament. The All Star rosters are comprised of the eligible players that competed during league play at the Minor, Major and Junior levels. The teams are selected by peers, coaches and commitment forms. The All Star experience is a tremendous honor for the players.

In order to be eligible and considered for an All Star Team, this form MUST be returned to your regular season team coach, or the NLLL All Star Coordinator Megan Turner (events@northlakell.org) by Tuesday, May 7th, 2019. No exceptions! If you have any questions, please talk to your coach.

To be considered for an All Star Team you must have played 60% of your regular season games and must agree to the following:

All Star teams can be announced as early as 12:01am June 1st. You must be available for announcement, meetings, practices, etc. starting on June 1st.

Beginning from the time of announcements of player placement through the end of the District 8 All Star Tournaments (see tentative dates below), **I have no scheduled vacations, other sports, camps or any other commitments that will interfere with my attendance at practices and games**. Most teams will hold practices daily. Only excused absences are allowed during the practice period. Teams may also decide to participate in a practice tournament prior to the District 8 tournament.

We understand that while the chances of an All Star team advancing beyond the District tournament is small, we agree to not schedule vacation or other activities that will interfere with our child's ability to attend practices and games during the full All Star period as noted below. If my team advances to the state tournament and it requires travel, we understand our family will incur additional costs related to hotel fees, gas, food, entertainment etc. All Star Tournaments are double elimination. I understand my commitment ends when my team has lost two games in a single tournament.

Only Majors and Juniors divisions can advance beyond State to Regional or World Series.

Signing this document does not mean that you are guaranteed a position on one of the teams, it simply will let us know that you wish to be considered.

Please Note: being selected to represent North Lake Little League is an honor, and players should treat it as such. Therefore, players will be committed to play for the team to which they are selected, without having the ability to force their way onto an older or younger team. Players opting to not play for a specific team are in effect opting to not play All Stars.

Mandatory Documentation:

Team Selection:

I understand that based on my age, I could be selected to play on one of two possible teams (8-10, 9-11, 10-12) or a Juniors team (13/14). I understand and agree to play on the team for which I am selected. If I am selected to a team, and decide not to play with that age group, I am forfeiting my eligibility for All Stars.

Team Uniform:

I will be given a team uniform to wear during All Stars and understand that I will need to return it at the end of the All Star season. I understand that anytime I am wearing my uniform my actions and behaviors represent our league, my family and myself. Players will be responsible for all of their own equipment. Additional All Star clothing (jackets/hats etc.) can be purchased from a vendor at a Team meeting.

Mandatory Minimum Play Time Rule:

I understand that based on Little League Tournament rule 9 if a tournament team has thirteen (13) or more eligible players in uniform at a game, then every player on a team roster shall participate in each game for a minimum of one (1) at bat. If a tournament team has twelve (12) or fewer eligible players in uniform at a game, then every player on a team roster shall participate in each game for a minimum of six (6) consecutive defensive outs and bat at least one (1) time. I also understand that the continuous batting order is not used in All Star Tournaments. Players may only receive the minimum play time and this is solely the All Star team managers discretion.
